


My Career Options


From the Home page, click on the green signpost icon, or on "Explore options" below the introduction.


Career suggestions are shown in categories, starting with Job Profiles, Industries and Types of Modern Apprenticeship

Role info

You would serve customers and look after the animate in a pat shop. You might sell rodents, fiels, birds and other pats as well as capes, food and accessories.

The animals would depend on you to treat them well while they were in your care. You would need to keep them healthy and happy and make sure that each customer is pleased with the pat they will take home.

You would:

- Give food and water to the animals
- . Groom the animats and clean out their cages
- Exercise the animals if needed
- Promote animal welfare and advise customers on caring for their pets
- Sel pet care products
- Look after stock levels and deal with deliveries
- Keep the shop clean and tidy
- Check the water temperature and chemical balance in fish tanks
- Check the animals' health and take them to a veterinary surgeon if they are it.


You'd need to be confident hending many different pets. It would be important for you to understand health and sofully guidelines.

Some shops specialise in a particular type of animal. For ecentryle, equatic centres sell mainly fish. If you were based in a specialist shop, you would be expected to provide more in-depth information to customers.


Personal Qualities
