How do I get a HYPE Learning Agreement?

You can discuss this with a careers adviser, a guidance teacher, or school key worker.

They will make sure there is a HYPE Keyworker to work with you to set up a learning programme which meets your needs.

What is a **HYPE** Learning Agreement?

A HYPE Learning Agreement is a plan of learning and activity which an advisor will help you pull together, so that when you are ready you can move on from this to further education, training or employment.

Financial Support

You may be eligible to receive EMA (Education Maintenance Allowance) of £30 per week.



Who is a HYPE Learning Agreement for?

Young people are eligible if they:

- + Have left school
- Are unable to access other post school opportunities due to challenges such as prolonged absence from school or no qualifications.
- + Are aged between 16-24

Examples of the Types of Learning on Offer

There is a range of training courses on offer, but you can also access training and support that is individual to your interests and needs e.g. a gym membership, counselling or bespoke training courses.
